## I. A Little BACKGROUND

- A. Written by PAUL
- B. Written in A.D. 60-61
  - THIRTEEN years after Paul's FIRST visit on second mission trip (Acts 18:18-28)
    - a. Accompanied by PRISCILLA and AQUILLA
    - b. Lasted only THREE MONTHS
  - 2. EIGHT years after Paul's SECOND visit on third mission trip (Acts 19:1-41)
    - a. Lasted THREE YEARS
    - b. Ended in RIOT caused by Demetrius the silversmith
  - 3. THREE to FIVE years after his meeting with the elders in Miletus (Acts 20:18-35)
  - 4. During Paul's FIRST imprisonment, while under house arrest in a place he had rented, awaiting trial before NERO
- C. Addressed to BELIEVERS "at EPHESUS"
  - 1. Destination MISSING from many EARLY MSS

- 2. Delivered by Tychicus, who also carried the Epistle to the COLOSSIANS (Eph. 6:21-22; Col. 4:7; cf. 2 Tim. 4:12)
- 3. Destination IDENTIFIED from mid-FOURTH century

## II. A Brief OVERVIEW

- A. Emphasizes our SPIRITUAL RICHES in Christ
  - 1. They are UNLIMITED (1:3; 3:8)
  - 2. They are UNENDING (1:4-5; 3:20-21)
  - 3. They are UNDESERVED (1:6; 2:8-10)
- B. Teaches much about the CHURCH
  - 1. The church as a MYSTERY (3:3-5)
  - 2. The church as the BODY of CHRIST (1:23; 5:30)
- C. Instructs believers in our CHRISTIAN WALK
  - 1. Chapters 1 through 3 contain DOCTRINAL instruction on our POSITION in Christ
  - 2. Chapters 4 through 6 make PRACTICAL applications to our RESPONSIBILITIES in Christ
