PRAYER FOR UNDERSTANDING, part 1 (Ephesians 1:15-18)

- I. Its CHARACTER (Eph. 1:15-16)
 - A. The prayer was INFORMED (1:15)
 - 1. The OBJECT of their faith
 - a. They had FORSAKEN Diana
 - b. They had believed in the LORD JESUS
 - 2. The EVIDENCE of their faith: their LOVE for ALL the saints (cf. John 13:35)
 - B. The prayer was INTERCESSORY (1:16)
 - 1. It was CONTINUING
 - 2. It was THANKFUL
- II. Its CONTENT (Eph. 1:17-23)
 - A. Introduced with REVERENCE (1:17*a*)
 - 1. To the GOD of our LORD JESUS CHRIST (cf. Matt. 27:46; John 20:17)
 - 2. To the FATHER of GLORY

- B. Included REQUESTS (1:17*b*-18*a*)
 - 1. That God would give them "a spirit of WISDOM and of REVELATION" (cf. James 1:5)
 - 2. That God would give them ENLIGHTENED EYES (cf. 1 Cor. 2:9-14)—an understanding so thorough that it CHANGES the way we THINK, FEEL, and ACT
- C Anticipated RESULTS (1:18*b*)
 - 1. That they would understand "the HOPE of His CALLING"
 - a. Not that they might be SAVED
 - b. But that they might understand what their salvation MEANS
 - 2. That they would understand "the RICHES of the GLORY His INHERITANCE in the SAINTS"
 - 3. That they would understand the "GREATNESS of His POWER"
