EPILOGUE (Esther 9:20 – 10:3)

I. Establishing an ANNUAL HOLIDAY (Esther 9:20-32)

- A. The INSTRUCTION from Mordecai (9:20-25)
 - 1. Perhaps Mordecai WROTE this BOOK (9:20)
 - 2. He COMMANDED the Jews to celebrate ANNUALLY (9:21-23)
 - 3. It was to commemorate their VICTORY over their ENEMIES
 - 4. Haman's casting PUR to destroy the Jews had been OVERTURNED to his and his family's DESTRUCTION (9:24-25)
- B. The REACTION of the Jews (9:26-28)
 - 1. They NAMED the new holiday PURIM
 - 2. They ESTABLISHED the annual holiday for both JEWS and CONVERTS
 - They intended EVERY JEW to participate and EVERY GENERATION to REMEMBER (9:27-28)
- C. The CONFIRMATION from Esther (9:29-32)
 - 1. Adds the AUTHORITY of the QUEEN
 - 2. Addresses ALL the Jews in the EMPIRE
 - 3. Includes "words of PEACE and TRUTH"
 - 4. Includes instruction for FASTING

II. Extolling a NATIONAL HERO (Esther 10:1-3)

- A. GREATNESS of Mordecai preserved in the IMPERIAL chronicles (10:1-2)
 - 1. He increased the WEALTH and POWER of King Ahasuerus
 - 2. He was rewarded with SUPERIOR RANK in the empire
- B. GRATITUDE for Mordecai preserved in the JEWISH community (10:3)
 - 1. His leadership brought PROSPERITY and PEACE to the JEWS
 - 2. His leadership brought WEALTH and SECURITY to the EMPIRE

III. Lessons

- A. We see God KEEPING His promise to ABRAHAM (cf. Gen. 12:3)
 - 1. He will BLESS those who BLESS his descendants
 - 2. He will CURSE those who CURSE his descendants
 - 3. Through his descendants ALL the peoples of the EARTH will be BLESSED
- B. We learn to TRUST God's GUIDANCE
- C. We learn to ACT for God's GLORY as we have OPPORTUNITY
- D. We are reminded that "He who PROMISED is FAITHFUL" (Heb. 10:23)
