NEHEMIAH'S CREW (Nehemiah 3:1-32)

I. ORGANIZATION of the Project

- A. The ORDER of construction highlights rebuilding of the GATES
 - 1. The NORTHERN section (3:1-7)
 - 2. The WESTERN section (3:8-13)
 - 3. The SOUTHERN section (3:14)
 - 4. The EASTERN section (3:15-32)
- B. Many also built SECTIONS of the WALL
 - 1. Some were REBUILT on their old FOUNDATIONS
 - 2. Some were NEW CONSTRUCTION along a NEW LINE
 - 3. Some sections were SHORT (vv. 21-23), and one was exceptionally LONG (v. 13)

C. Odd details

- 1. The "NOBLES" of Tekoa REFUSED to help (v. 5)
- 2. The crew from Tekoa repaired a SECOND SECTION (v. 27)
- 3. Baruch was especially ZEALOUS in his work (v. 20)
- 4. The Tower of FURNACES (v. 11) was named for the OVENS for baking BREAD and firing POTTERY

- 5. Beth-haccerem was a SIGNAL FIRE location (v. 14, cf. Jer. 6:1)
- 6. The "upper house" was probably SOLOMON'S palace (v. 25)

II. PARTICIPATION in the Project

- A. A wide range of SOCIAL CLASSES helped build
 - 1. PRIESTS, including the HIGH PRIEST (v. 1, 4, 19, 21, 22, 28)
 - 2. LEVITES (vv. 2, 17)
 - 3. Temple SERVANTS (v. 26)
 - 4. District OFFICIALS (vv. 13, 14, 15, 16, 17, 18, 19)
 - 5. VILLAGERS (vv. 5, 7, 13)
 - 6. Even a few WOMEN (v. 12)

B. OCCUPATIONS

- 1. GOLDSMITHS (v. 8, 31, 32)
- 2. PERFUMERS (v. 8)
- 3. But no professional MASONS or CARPENTERS are listed

III. SIGNIFICANCE of the Project

- A. Provided SECURITY, especially for the TEMPLE
- B. Provided distinctive IDENTITY for the PEOPLE of God
- C. Signaled a reversal of HUMILIATION and DEFEAT
- D. Demonstrated their RESTORATION to FELLOWSHIP with God
