NEHEMIAH'S OPPOSITION (Nehemiah 4:1-23)

I. Dealing with RIDICULE (Neh. 4:1-6)

- A. Sanballat, governor of SYRIA, was FURIOUS/INCENSED (4:1)
- B. His immediate response was MOCKERY (4:2)
- C. Tobiah ridiculed the QUALITY/DURABILITY of their work (4:3)
- D. Nehemiah PRAYED for God's JUDGMENT on His enemies (4:4-5)
- E. They built the ENTIRE wall to HALF its height (4:6)

II. Delayed by OBSTACLES (Neh. 4:7-14)

- A. Enemies made THREATS (4:7-9)
 - 1. They were ANGRY with the PROGRESS on the wall
 - 2. They CONSPIRED to DISRUPT the work
 - 3. Nehemiah led in PRAYER and established SECURITY
- B. The workers became WEARY (4:10)
- C. The people became FEARFUL (4:11-14)
 - 1. Enemies threatened to MURDER them by STEALTH
 - 2. Jews who lived near the BORDERS reported this CONSTANTLY
 - 3. Nehemiah posted ARMED GUARDS at vulnerable points

- 4. Nehemiah challenged them to ABANDON fear, REMEMBER God's power, and FIGHT
- III. Defending the WORK (Neh. 4:15-23)
 - A. Half the BUILDERS became ARMED GUARDS while the other half BUILT (4:16)
 - B. The PORTERS carried one-handed and held a WEAPON in the other (4:17)
 - C. The BUILDERS carried a SWORD in a sheath (4:18a)
 - D. Nehemiah organized an ALARM system (4:18b-20)
 - E. Nehemiah took steps to ACCELERATE the project (4:21-23)
 - 1. They worked LONGER HOURS
 - 2. All the workers stayed in JERUSALEM
 - 3. No one took time to BATHE or change CLOTHES
 - 4. No one went to get WATER without his WEAPON

IV. Lessons

- A. God usually uses HUMAN AGENCY to accomplish His will
- B. God helps those who TRUST in HIM and DO His WILL
- C. God delights in using the WEAK to accomplish His will (1 Cor. 1:27-29)
