THE HOLINESS OF GOD (Isaiah 6:1-3)

I. God's Holiness DEFINED

- A. Primary meaning is "SEPARATE" or "SET APART"
- B. Secondary meaning is "PERFECT" or "untainted by EVIL"
 - 1. God is without ERROR in all His ways
 - 2. God never makes a MISJUDGMENT
 - 3. God never CAUSES something to happen that is not RIGHT
- C. Corollary demands that He exercise JUSTICE
 - 1. God cannot TOLERATE any INIQUITY
 - 2. God pours out WRATH on all SIN

II. God's Holiness SURVEYED

- A. God's Holy HABITATION (Isa. 63:15)
 - 1. Lucifer was cast out when UNRIGHTEOUSNESS was found in him
 - 2. Any who would DWELL in His presence must also be HOLY
- B. God's Holy CREATION (Gen. 1:31)
 - 1. He examined it ALL and said it was "VERY GOOD"
 - 2. Adam and Eve were cast out when they became SINNERS

- C. God's Holy GROUND (Ex. 3:5)
 - 1. The DIRT was holy because GOD was there
 - 2. Anyplace God is PRESENT is immediately SANCTIFIED
 - 3. We must approach Him in SUBMISSION with CONTRITION and REVERENCE
- D. God's Holy MOUNTAIN (Ps. 48:1; cf. Exodus 19:9-25)
 - 1. Any who TOUCHED the mountain would be EXECUTED
 - 2. All who WITNESSED God's presence were TERRIFIED
- E. God's Holy LAW (Ex. 20:1-17)
 - 1. They must have no OTHER GODS before Him
 - 2. They must construct no MAN-MADE IMAGE of Him
 - 3. They must never use His NAME in VAIN
 - 4. They must never FORGET the Sabbath as a day of WORSHIP
 - 5. They must construct a Tabernacle of a particular DESIGN
 - 6. They must offer SACRIFICES to APPROACH Him
- F. God's Holy THRONE (Ps. 47:8)
 - 1. It is EXALTED and MAJESTIC
 - 2. It is surrounded by ANGELIC PRAISE for God's FUNDAMENTAL holiness
- G. God's Holy SON (Luke 1:35)
 - 1. He was TEMPTED in EVERY way, but remained SINLESS
 - 2. His holiness is evident in His WORDS, LIFE, and MIRACLES

3. He DIED on the CROSS to SATISFY God's REQUIREMENTS for holiness
