SERVANT-MASTER RELATIONSHIPS (Ephesians 6:5-9)

- I. Background Observations
 - A. The NT recognizes the EXISTENCE of SLAVERY as a socio-economic institution
 - 1. It does not CONDONE it
 - 2. It does not CONDEMN it
 - B. OT Israel practiced SLAVERY in three cases
 - 1. PRISONERS of WAR—rare and unsanctioned
 - 2. DEBTORS and/or THIEVES
 - 3. VOLUNTARY for a specified PURPOSE and PERIOD
 - C. Christianity leads to FREEING slaves and JUST treatment
- II. Exhortations to SERVANTS/EMPLOYEES (Eph. 6:5-8)
 - A. Concerning OBEDIENCE (6:5-7)
 - 1. Demands CONSTANT obedience
 - 2. They are your "MASTERS according to the FLESH"
 - a. Authority is MATERIAL and earth-bound
 - b. You remain spiritually FREE
 - 3. With SERIOUSNESS and ENERGY

- 4. In SINCERITY of heart
- 5. As to CHRIST (v. 5; cf. vv. 6, 7)
- 6. Not for APPEARANCE sake, but with sincere GOOD WILL
- B. Concerning ENCOURAGEMENT (6:8)—REWARDS from the LORD for GOOD things done
- III. Exhortation to MASTERS/ EMPLOYERS (Eph. 6:9)
 - A. Not "render the SAME SERVICE"
 - B. But "treat with the same CONSIDERATION"
 - 1. Forsaking THREATENING
 - 2. Remembering ACCOUNTABILITY

IV. Conclusions

- A. God will reward EMPLOYERS who treat their EMPLOYEES as if they were Christ
- B. God will reward EMPLOYEES who treat their EMPLOYERS as if they were Christ
- C. The POWER of the Holy Spirit within will help each OVERLOOK PERSONALITIES
 - 1. The Spirit-filled employee will be joyful, thankful, SUBMISSIVE, and HARD WORKING
 - 2. The Spirit-filled employer will be joyful, thankful, HUMBLE, and GENEROUS
