## THE DIVINE LINEAGE OF THE KING (Matthew 1:18-25)

- I. Virgin Conception DISCOVERED (Matt. 1:18)
  - A. His mother, MARY, is introduced without FANFARE
    - 1. She is not PROMINENT in Matthew
    - 2. We know of her GODLINESS, HUMILITY, and FAITH (Luke 1:26-38, 45-55)
    - 3. She was BETROTHED to Joseph
    - 4. She was still a VIRGIN
  - B. She "was FOUND" to be "with CHILD"
    - 1. Her pregnancy became EVIDENT
    - 2. Her child had been conceived by the HOLY SPIRIT
- II. Virgin Conception CONSIDERED (Matt. 1:19-20)
  - A. Joseph was "a RIGHTEOUS man"
    - 1. He could not marry an ADULTERESS
    - 2. He decided on a QUIET DIVORCE
  - B. He received a DIVINE MESSAGE while he slept
    - 1. The messenger was "an ANGEL of the Lord"

- 2. He addresses Joseph as "SON of DAVID"
- 3. He was told he must not be AFRAID
- 4. He should proceed with the WEDDING
- 5. Her pregnancy was CAUSED by the HOLY SPIRIT
- III. Virgin Conception EXPLAINED (Matt. 1:21-23)
  - A. Mary will give birth to a SON
    - 1. He is to be named JESUS
    - 2. "He will SAVE His people from their SINS"
  - B. "All this..." was a FULFILLMENT of prophecy (cf. Isa. 7:14)
    - 1. A VIRGIN would bear a SON
    - 2. His name would be Immanuel, meaning "GOD WITH US"
- IV. Virgin Conception ACCEPTED (Matt. 1:24-25)
  - A. Setting aside FEAR, Joseph TOOK Mary as his WIFE
  - B. Heeding SCRIPTURE, Joseph "KEPT [Mary] a VIRGIN"
    - 1. Mary was still a virgin when THIS Son was BORN
    - 2. Mary remained a virgin ONLY UNTIL this Son was born
  - C. Obeying the COMMAND, Joseph NAMED the boy JESUS
- V. Virgin Conception BELIEVED (cf. Matt. 22:42)
  - A. Many DENY it
  - B. Others DOUBT it
  - C. But the Bible DEMANDS it
