THE MINISTRY OF JOHN THE BAPTIST, PART 2 (Matthew 3:3-6)

I. John's MISSION (Matt. 3:3)

- A. It EQUATED Jesus with the OT YAHWEH
 - Isaiah said he would make the way "straight" for YAHWEH, whom he called "our GOD"
 - 2. John came making the way "straight" for JESUS
- B. It FULFILLED prophecy (cf. Isa. 40:3)
 - 1. He was the King's HERALD
 - 2. He made the proclamation "in the WILDERNESS"
 - 3. He called the people to prepare their HEARTS to RECEIVE the King
- II. John's APPEARANCE (Matt. 3:4)
 - A. His CLOTHING was ROUGH
 - 1. It was the garb of the POOR
 - 2. It was like the garb of ELIJAH (cf. 2 Kings 1:8)
 - B. His FOOD was MEAGER

- C. His LIFESTYLE was a REBUKE
- III. John's IMPACT (Matt. 3:5-6)
 - A. People "were GOING" to him from a WIDE territory
 - 1. They were coming from JERUSALEM
 - 2. They were coming from "ALL JUDEA"
 - 3. They were coming from "ALL the DISTRICT around the Jordan"
 - B. People "were being" BAPTIZED by him
 - 1. He was IMMERSING them in the JORDAN
 - 2. JEWS were coming to John to be admitted to the people of GOD
 - C. They CONFESSED their SINS

IV. John's GREATNESS

- A. He was FILLED with the SPIRIT (Luke 1:15*b*)
- B. He was OBEDIENT to God's WORD (Luke 1:16-17)
- C. He was SELF-CONTROLLED (Luke 1:15*a*)
- D. He was HUMBLE (Mark 1:7; John 3:30)
- E. He was COURAGEOUS (Matt. 14:3-12)
- F. He faithfully POINTED people to CHRIST (Luke 1:16)
