IS THE BIBLE HISTORICALLY ACCURATE? PART 1: New TESTAMENT ACCURACY

- I. Selected Archeological Evidence Supporting the New Testament.
 - A. Confirmation that PILATE was Prefect in JUDEA came in 1961
 - B. Independent evidence of NAZARETH first found in 1962
 - C. Evidence found in Capernaum of PETER'S home (Mk. 1:29-34; 2:1)
 - D. Capernaum shown to produce and export MILLSTONES (Luke 17:2, 35)
 - E. A 1st century FISHING BOAT consistent with PETER'S discovered along the shore of the Sea of Galilee
 - F. The "chair of MOSES" was an actual stone seat for TEACHERS (Matt. 23:2)
 - G. The "POOL of BETHESDA" was found in Jerusalem (John 5:2)
 - H. The TEMPLE was more SPECTACULAR than usually imagined (cf. Mark 13:1)
 - I. The Jews ADMITTED the tomb was empty and accused the disciples of STEALING Jesus' body (Matt. 28:11-15)
- II. The Reliability of LUKE, the Consummate HISTORIAN
 - A. Confirmed facts surrounding the BIRTH of Jesus (Luke 2:1-3)
 - 1. The fact of the Roman CENSUS

- 2. That Quirinius was GOVERNOR in SYRIA
- 3. The requirement to REGISTER in one's HOMETOWN
- B. Concerning HISTORICAL references
 - 1. Luke was right about territorial BORDERS
 - 2. He identified Lysanias as TETRARCH (Luke 3:1)
 - 3. He described a civic *Ecclesia* in a THEATER in EPHESUS (Acts 19:23ff)
 - 4. He uses correct terms for DISTRICTS, GOVERNING bodies, and government OFFICIALS
- III. The Accuracy of PAUL in Romans 16:23—pavement discovered in 1929 identifies ERASTUS as "curator of PUBLIC BUILDINGS"
