THE BLESSEDNESS OF BEING HUMBLE (Matthew 5:3)

I. The Beatitudes

- A. The MEANING of "BLESSED"
 - 1. Often treated as a synonym for "HAPPY"
 - 2. Emphasis is on FUTURE "blessedness" in the KINGDOM
 - 3. CONTENTEDNESS or SATISFACTION that is rooted not in one's SELF or CIRCUMSTANCES, but in PEACE with GOD
- B. The CHARACTER of the Beatitudes
 - 1. Confront our natural search for SATISFACTION in the PHYSICAL
 - 2. Reveal that our SPIRITS find TRUE satisfaction in the SPIRITUAL (Col. 3:1-2; 1 John 2:15, 17)
 - 3. Are divine JUDGMENTAL PRONOUNCEMENTS
 - 4. Are PROGRESSIVE
- II. The POOR in SPIRIT (Matt. 5:3)
 - A. Its MEANING
 - 1. Refers to being spiritually DESTITUTE
 - 2. Requires DEPENDENCE on GIFTS for sustenance
 - 3. Recognizes one's HELPLESS condition

B. Its PRIORITY

- 1. HUMILITY is the FOUNDATION of all other graces
- 2. Humility must PRECEDE everything else

C. Its ACHIEVEMENT

- 1. Cannot START with YOU
- 2. Not a human WORK to make you WORTHY
- 3. But a DIVINE work revealing your UNWORTHINESS
 - a. Change focus from SELF to GOD (Col. 3:2)
 - b. STARVE the flesh (Col. 3:5, 8-9; Phil 2:12-13)
 - c. ASK GOD for it (Ps. 51:10)
- D. Its CHARACTERISTICS
 - 1. WEANED from SELF (Gal. 2:20)
 - 2. LOST in the WONDER of Christ (2 Cor. 3:18)
 - 3. UNCOMPLAINING about your situation (Rom. 8:18)
 - Recognize others' VIRTUES and your own SINS (Rom. 12:10; Phil 2:3)
 - 5. Spend much time in PRAYER
 - 6. Take Christ on HIS TERMS
 - 7. Will PRAISE and THANK God for His GRACE
- E. Its REWARD: participation in the KINGDOM of HEAVEN (Isa. 57:15)
