THE BLESSEDNESS OF SPIRITUAL HUNGER (Matthew 5:6)

- I. The MEANING of Spiritual Hunger
 - A. Focused on what is NECESSARY
 - 1. For LIFE
 - 2. For HEALTH
 - B. Includes INTENSE longing
 - 1. Will find appetizing ONLY what GOD PROVIDES
 - 2. Will strive to acquire ALL that GOD PROVIDES
- II. The OBJECT of Spiritual Hunger
 - A. Initial JUSTFICATION by the application of CHRIST'S righteousness for SALVATION
 - 1. Acquiring admission into the KINGDOM
 - 2. Craving God's GIFT of a righteousness NOT YOUR OWN
 - B. Perpetual GROWTH in PERSONAL righteousness through SANCTIFICATION
 - 1. Cannot be FULLY realized in THIS LIFE

- 2. Requires CONSTANT longing to be MORE righteous
- C. Ultimate EXPERIENCE of PERFECT righteousness in GLORIFICATION
 - 1. Where our OWN righteousness is made PERFECT
 - 2. Where CHRIST'S righteousness if fully realized in the demonstration of perfect JUSTICE
- III. The EVIDENCE of Spiritual Hunger
 - A. Cease being SATISFIED with SELF
 - B. Cease being DEPENDENT on EXTERNAL THINGS for satisfaction
 - 1. Includes REJECTION of EVIL activities as harmful
 - 2. Includes DEVALUING of GOOD activities as insufficient
 - C. Craving for GOD'S WORD
 - D. Finding PLEASURE in the things of GOD
 - 1. Takes comfort in the CHASTENING of God (Heb. 12:6)
 - 2. Make choices that might appear humanly DISASTROUS
 - E. Embracing ALL of God's INSTRUCTION and PROVISION
- IV. The RESULT of Spiritual Hunger
 - A. Will find it SATISFYING in THIS LIFE
 - B. Will be fully SATISFIED in the ETERNAL KINGDOM
