## Matthew—37

## A MODEL FOR PRAYING, PART 1 (Matthew 6:9-15)

## I. God's PURPOSE (Matt. 6:9*a*)

- A. Revealed in some things He DOES NOT address
  - 1. No mention of a PLACE for prayer
  - 2. No setting of a TIME for prayer
  - 3. No description of a POSTURE or ATTIRE for prayer
- B. Intended as a TEMPLATE for our OWN prayers
- C. Text is both CONCISE and PROFOUND
- D. Shows that prayer must not be MAN-CENTERED
  - 1. Not focused on our NEEDS
  - 2. Not laying CLAIM to God's PROMISES
  - 3. Not making DEMANDS of God
- E. Demonstrates that prayer must be GOD-CENTERED
  - 1. Must acknowledge God's SOVEREIGNTY
  - 2. Seeks to DISPLAY God's GLORY
  - 3. Prompts our SUBMISSION to God's WILL

- II. God's PATERNITY (Matt. 6:9*b*)
  - A. Not the UNIVERSAL fatherhood of God as CREATOR (Mal. 2:10; Acts 17:28)
  - B. But the SPIRITUAL fatherhood of God through REDEMPTION (John 1:12-13)
    - 1. Means the end of FEAR
    - 2. Settles UNCERTAINTIES and gives HOPE
    - 3. Resolves LONELINESS
    - 4. Should settle the matter of SELFISHNESS
    - 5. Settles the matter of RESOURCES
    - 6. Should settle the matter of OBEDIENCE

## III. God's PRIORITY (Matt. 6:9*c*)

- A. His NAME includes recognizing His CHARACTER
- B. Demands REVERENCE, for He alone is HOLY
  - 1. Begins by acknowledging He EXISTS
  - 2. Includes understanding TRUTH about Him
  - 3. Demands conformity to His WILL
  - 4. Will ATTRACT others by our commitment
