A MODEL FOR PRAYING, PART 2 (Matthew 6:9-15)

- I. God's PROGRAM (Matt. 6:10*a*)
 - A. For INDIVIDUALS to be TRANSFORMED in SALVATION
 - B. For the CONSUMMATION of the Kingdom in GLORY
- II. God's PLAN (Matt. 6:10b)
 - A. Prayer is NOT trying to get MY will done in HEAVEN
 - B. Prayer is asking for GOD'S will to be done on EARTH
 - 1. To OVERRULE man's rebellion and bring RIGHTEOUSNESS
 - 2. To FULLY ACCOMPLISH all events to fulfill His PROGRAM
 - 3. That His will be done OPENLY, SPONTANEOUSLY, and ONLY
- III. God's PROVISION (Matt. 6:11)
 - A. We ask God for FOOD
 - B. We ask God for DAILY supply
 - C. We DEPEND on GOD to provide
 - 1. Does not DIMINISH our responsibility to WORK

- 2. Reminds us that ALL GOOD THINGS come from God
- IV. God's PARDON (Matt. 6:12)
 - A. We are all LAWBREAKERS
 - B. We need to CONFESS our SINS to God daily
 - C. We need to FORGIVE OTHERS their DEBTS owed US
- V. God's PROTECTION (Matt. 6:13*a*)
 - A. We depend upon His GUIDANCE to AVOID evil
 - B. We depend upon His STRENGTH to RESIST evil
 - C. We depend upon His RESCUE from ultimate JUDGMENT
- [VI. God's PREEMINENCE (Matt. 6:13b)]
- VII. God's POSTSCRIPT (Matt. 6:14-15)
 - A. An unforgiving spirit is INCONSISTENT with the EXPERIENCE of forgiveness
 - B. God's people must treat each other with FORGIVENESS for our PRAYERS to be EFFECTIVE
