Maintaining Unswerving Loyalty to the Values of the Kingdom (Matthew 6:19-24)

- I. STRIVE for a Single TREASURE (Matt. 6:19-21)
 - [A. Beware adopting common MISAPPLICATIONS]
 - 1. "POVERTY is the path to SPIRITUALITY"
 - 2. "We should not INVEST or SAVE for the future"
 - 3. "WEALTH is intrinsically EVIL"
 - B. Don't treasure MATERIAL WEALTH (6:19)
 - 1. To "lay up...treasure" implies HOARDING
 - 2. We're forbidden to do so for SELF INTEREST
 - 3. We're warned that its value is TEMPORARY and MEAGER
 - C. Instead treasure HEAVENLY WEALTH (6:20; cf. 6:4*b*, 6*b*, 18*b*)
 - 1. It's the REWARD given by GOD for GENUINE righteousness
 - 2. Its STORAGE place is SECURE
 - 3. Its value is VAST and ETERNAL
 - D. The KIND of wealth you treasure REVEALS the ORIENTATION of your HEART (6:21)

- II. FOCUS on a Single VISION (Matt. 6:22-23)
 - A. A "clear" eye ADMITS LIGHT (6:22)
 - 1. It allows CLARITY of VISION
 - 2. It promotes SINGLENESS of FOCUS
 - 3. It reveals the GLORY of CHRIST (cf. Matt. 17:5)
 - B. A "bad" eye ENCLOSES DARKNESS (6:23)
 - 1. It makes one MORALLY and SPIRITUALLY blind
 - 2. It results in SELF-DECEPTION
 - 3. It promotes SELF-INDULGENCE
- III. SLAVE for a Single MASTER (Matt. 6:24)
 - A. As a SLAVE, you are OWNED by your master
 - B. You cannot SPLIT your LOYALTY
 - 1. To SLAVE for WEALTH, you must turn you back on GOD
 - 2. To SLAVE for GOD'S GLORY, you must turn your back on EARTHLY TREASURE
 - 3. To try to do both is not a COMPROMISE; it is SURRENDER to IDOLATRY
