PRAY FOR LOVING DISCERNMENT (Matthew 7:7-12)

- I. Kingdom Living Is ENABLED by God's PROMISE to Us (Matt. 7:7-8)
 - A. Instructions are stated TWICE
 - 1. The one who ASKS will RECEIVE
 - 2. The one who SEEKS will FIND
 - 3. The one who KNOCKS will have it OPENED
 - B. Promise is made to BELIEVERS
 - 1. It does not apply to all PEOPLE without DISTINCTION
 - 2. It applies to all BELIEVERS without EXCEPTION (cf. James 4:2)
 - C. Promise assumes the intent to OBEY (cf. 1 John 3:22)
 - D. Promise depends on right MOTIVES (cf. James 4:3)
 - E. Promise expects undiluted LOYALTY (Matt. 6:24; cf. James 1:7-8)
 - F. Promise reflects our CONSTANT need for His AID
- II. Kingdom Living Is DEPICTED by God's PATTERN for Us (Matt. 7:9-11)
 - A. Applies to ANY FATHER

- 1. He would give his son a LOAF, not a STONE
- 2. He would give his son a FISH, not a SNAKE
- B. Compares to GOD THE FATHER
 - 1. Human fathers, by nature EVIL, still know to give GOOD gifts to their CHILDREN
 - 2. Your Father in HEAVEN is PERFECT, and will ALWAYS "give what is GOOD" to those who ASK
- III. Kingdom Living Is DEMANDED by God's PURPOSE in Us (Matt. 7:12)
 - A. Many have stated this principle NEGATIVELY
 - B. Only Jesus included doing POSITIVE GOOD for others
 - 1. It encompasses quantity: "in EVERYTHING"
 - 2. Motive is NOT so that you will be treated BETTER
 - 3. Motive is to OBEY GOD
