Genesis—7

THE FALL OF MAN, PART 2 (Genesis 3:6-24)

- I. Man and SIN (Gen. 3:6-13)
 - A. The willful SIN (3:6)
 - 1. The APPEAL (cf. 1 John 2:16)
 - a. To the LUST of the FLESH: "good for FOOD"
 - b. To the LUST of the EYES: "DELIGHT ..."
 - c. To the PRIDE of LIFE: "to make one WISE"
 - 2. The ACT
 - a. She TOOK and ATE its fruit
 - b. She gave some to ADAM, who was WITH HER
 - B. The immediate SHAME (3:7*a*)
 - C. The inadequate SOLUTION (3:7*b*-13)
 - 1. Tried to hide by their OWN EFFORTS
 - 2. Tried to explain why they were ASHAMED
 - a. May be RATIONALIZING
 - b. May be REPENTING

II. Creation and the CURSE (Gen. 3:14-24)

- A. The demoted SERPENT (3:14)
 - 1. Cursed MORE THAN other animals
 - 2. Go upon its BELLY and "eat DUST": ETERNALLY
 - 3. Affected ALL of man's DOMINION

- B. The promised SEED (3:15-16)—*Protoevangelium*
 - 1. The SEED of the woman would ultimately DEFEAT the serpent, implying the VIRGIN BIRTH
 - 2. Imposed upon women greater PAIN in CHILDBIRTH and greater SUBJECTION to her HUSBAND
 - 3. Woman would neither SERVE the SERPENT nor CONTROL the MAN
- C. The lifelong SORROW (3:17-20)
 - 1. General curse upon ALL the "GROUND"
 - 2. Four-fold curse upon HUMANITY
 - a. SORROW: continual DISAPPOINTMENT and FUTILITY
 - b. PAIN and SUFFERING
 - c. SWEAT and TEARS
 - d. DEATH to TRIUMPH over all man's EFFORTS
 - 3. A ray of HOPE in Eve's name—"MOTHER of all LIVING"
- D. The covering SKINS (3:21)
 - 1. Required DEATH (cf. Heb. 9:22)
 - 2. Provided by GOD
- E. The enforced SEPARATION (3:22-24)
 - 1. A JUST punishment
 - 2. A CRUCIAL lesson
 - a. Without a STRUGGLE, sin ABOUNDS
 - b. Without DEATH, sin SURVIVES and redemption is IMPOSSIBLE
 - c. Without SEPARATION, the NATURE and EFFECTS of sin are not RECOGNIZED
 - 3. An appropriate GUARDIAN (cf. Ex. 25:18-20; Isa. 37:16; Heb. 9:5)
