## JESUS' POWER OVER DISEASE: LEPROSY (Matthew 8:1-4)

- I. Further Description of Jesus' Ministry in GALILEE (cf. Matt. 4:23-25)
  - A. Example of the King's ministry of TEACHING (Matt. 5:3 7:27)
  - B. Examples of the King's demonstrations of POWER (Matt. 8:1 9:38)
  - C. Begins with the King's power over DISEASE
    - 1. Healed without FANFARE
    - 2. Healed without DELAY
    - 3. Healed without RESTRICTION
- II. The Leper's APPROACH (Matt. 8:1-2)
  - A. His condition was DREADFUL
    - 1. A leper was DISFIGURED
    - 2. A leper was INCURABLE
    - 3. A leper was SHUNNED, even REPELLED
    - 4. A leper was considered CURSED by GOD
  - B. His PRESENTATION demonstrated simple FAITH
    - 1. He came CONFIDENTLY
    - 2. He came REVERENTLY

- 3. He came HUMBLY
- 4. He came BELIEVINGLY
- III. The King's RESPONSE (Matt. 8:3-4)
  - A. His ACTION was SHOCKING
    - 1. He TOUCHED the leper (cf. Lev. 13:3)
    - 2. He said, "I AM WILLING"
  - B. His WORDS were EFFECTIVE
    - 1. He said, "BE CLEANSED"
    - 2. The LEPROSY was IMMEDIATELY removed
  - C. His DIRECTIONS were PRACTICAL
    - 1. Tell NO ONE what JESUS had done
      - a. He was not a "wonderworker" playing to CROWDS
      - b. His authority derived from GOD, not popular acclaim
      - c. He came to DIE, not to defeat the ROMANS
    - 2. Present himself to the PRIEST for VERIFICATION
    - 3. Present the appropriate OFFERING as instructed in the LAW (cf. Lev. 14)
  - D. His HEALING was INSTRUCTIVE
    - 1. Leprosy is a vivid depiction of SIN
    - 2. The healing has many parallels with SALVATION
    - 3. The RESULT would be "a TESTIMONY to them"
