JESUS' POWER OVER DISEASE: PARALYSIS (Matthew 8:5-13)

- I. The Centurion's APPEAL (Matt. 8:5-6)
 - A. This occurred in CAPERNAUM (cf. 4:13)
 - B. He was approached by a CENTURION (cf. Luke 7:2-10)
 - 1. A GENTILE
 - 2. A COMMANDER of an OCCUPYING military force
 - 3. A FRIEND to the JEWS
 - C. He was told of a SERVANT who was SUFFERING
 - 1. Demonstrates COMPASSION for him
 - 2. Described him as PARALYZED and in great PAIN
 - 3. Implied desire for HEALING without REQUESTING it
- II. Jesus' REPLY (Matt. 8:7)
 - A. Jesus may have VOLUNTEERED to COME and HEAL him
 - B. Jesus may have been ASKING WHY the Centurion wanted JESUS' help
- III. The Centurion's UNDERSTANDING (Matt. 8:8-9)
 - A. He did not expect Jesus to COME to heal his servant
 - Did not want Jesus to violate Jewish CUSTOM and become ceremonially UNCLEAN

- 2. Acknowledged Jesus SUPERIOR RANK
- B. He believed that Jesus could heal with a WORD at a DISTANCE
- C. He understood how AUTHORITY works
 - He could order SOLDIERS or SLAVES to carry out HIS instructions
 - 2. He was ACCOUNTABLE to HIGHER authority
 - 3. He understood that Jesus was the REPRESENTATIVE of God on earth and acted on God's AUTHORITY
- IV. Jesus' EXPANDED Response (Matt. 8:10-13)
 - A. Jesus expressed WONDER at the man's profound FAITH
 - B. Jesus stated that as yet NO ONE in ISRAEL had expressed such GREAT FAITH
 - 1. Jesus healed without RITUAL, or MAGIC, or AID
 - 2. Jesus' word was EFFECTIVE because it was GOD'S word
 - C. Jesus declared that MANY GENTILES would be INCLUDED in His Kingdom
 - D. Jesus indicated that MANY JEWS would be EXCLUDED from His Kingdom
 - E. People enter the Kingdom through FAITH, not natural BIRTH
 - F. Jesus proclaimed the HEALING of the Centurion's servant
