Ron and Shelly Hamilton's oldest son, Jonathan, took his own life a few years ago. There is plenty of evidence that Jonathan was a genuine believer who suffered from severe bouts of depression caused by an acne medication he took for several years as a teen. He was a skilled pianist, and wrote the music for some of the songs included in our hymnal. In Shelly Hamilton's book, *Always, Only Good*, she says, "The last melody Jonathan wrote before he died was the tune to the song, "You Are Always Good." ... I try numerous times to write lyrics for the thoughts of God's goodness that I have in my heart, but without success. ... I give my ideas and Jon's melody to our friend, Chris Anderson, who ... pens a beautiful verse to Jonathan's haunting melody. Chris says he writes these lyrics as Jonathan's testimony, just as 'Rejoice in the Lord' is Ron's."
