OBSTACLES TO FOLLOWING CHRIST (Matthew 8:18-22)

- I. The DISTRACTION of the Pressing CROWD (Matt. 8:18)
 - A. He was being SWARMED by a CROWD
 - B. He instructed His DISCIPLES to prepare the BOAT so they could ESCAPE the crowd (cf. Mark 4:35-36)
 - 1. The CLAMOR would be EXHAUSTING
 - 2. POPULARITY would interfere with His MISSION
 - 3. ENTHUSIASM is not the same thing as CONVERSION (cf. Luke 8:5-15)
 - 4. Prevented real MINISTRY to INDIVIDUALS
- II. The EXPECTATION of Physical COMFORT (Matt. 8:19-20)
 - A. One was a SCRIBE
 - 1. A SCHOLAR specializing in Jewish LAW
 - 2. A TEACHER, not a FOLLOWER of a teacher
 - B. He VOLUNTEERED to accompany Jesus
 - 1. He called Jesus "TEACHER"

- 2. He said, "I'll FOLLOW You WHEREVER You go"
- C. Jesus told him the WAY would be DIFFICULT
 - 1. They will be CONSTANTLY on the MOVE
 - 2. They will have to PACK LIGHT and SLEEP ROUGH
- III. The COMPLICATION of Personal CONCERNS (Matt. 8:21-22)
 - A. He's called "ANOTHER DISCIPLE"
 - 1. "Disciples" had varying DEGREES of COMMITMENT
 - 2. Being "another" indicates BOTH MEN were "disciples"
 - B. He asked to be EXCUSED so he could BURY his father
 - 1. He may have wanted an INDEFINITE DELAY until his father DIED and he received his INHERITANCE
 - 2. He may have wanted a MONTH'S LEAVE for a FUNERAL and MOURNING period
 - C. Jesus commanded "FOLLOW ME" and explained that His MINISTRY was more IMPORTANT
 - 1. The world is TRANSIENT, His Kingdom is ETERNAL
 - 2. The GOSPEL of the Kingdom is more URGENT than temporal concerns
 - D. The COST of discipleship is HIGH
 - 1. Jesus was not recruiting ALL He could FIND
 - 2. Jesus was CALLING all who were HIS
