## THE KING'S AUTHORITY OVER THE NATURAL (Matthew 8:23-27)

- I. The SETTING (Matt. 8:23-24)
  - A. The DEPARTURE
    - 1. JESUS entered the BOAT
    - 2. His DISCIPLES followed Him (cf. Mark 4:36)
  - B. The WEATHER
    - 1. It changed SUDDENLY
    - 2. It produced a "GREAT STORM"
    - 3. Waves were SWAMPING the boat (cf. Mark 4:37)
  - C. The SLEEP: Jesus was ASLEEP in the STERN (cf. Mark 4:38)
    - 1. We get a GLIMPSE of His HUMANITY
    - 2. We get a DEMONSTRATION of His CONFIDENCE
- II. The SITUATION (Matt. 8:25-26a)
  - A. The PANIC
    - 1. They WOKE Jesus

- 2. They cried, "LORD, SAVE!"
- 3. They cried, "We are PERISHING!"
- B. The QUESTION
  - 1. Jesus asked, "WHY are you AFRAID..."
  - 2. Jesus chided, "...you men of LITTLE FAITH?"
- III. The SOVEREIGN (Matt. 8:26*b*-27*a*)
  - A. The REBUKE
    - 1. Jesus STOOD
    - 2. He rebuked the WINDS and the SEA
  - B. The RESULT
    - 1. The winds STOPPED
    - 2. The waves STILLED
- IV. The SIGNIFICANCE (Matt. 8:27)
  - A. The MAN: distinct from ALL OTHERS
  - B. The LORD: even the ELEMENTS obey HIM (cf. Job 38:8-11; Pss. 29:3-4, 10-11; 65:5-7; 89:9; 107:23-32)
