 - b. Among the TOMBS
 - 2. What they were DOING
 - a. "DEMONIZING" two men in particular
 - b. TERRORIZING the community

B. The RECOGNITION by the demons (8:29)

- 1. Whom they came to MEET
 - a. INTENTIONALLY approached JESUS
 - b. IDENTIFIED Him as the "SON OF GOD"
- 2. What they wanted to KNOW
 - a. WONDERED what BUSINESS He had with them
 - b. WORRIED what PLANS He had for them
- C. The REQUEST of the demons (8:30-31)

- 1. What they KNEW He would DO: EXPEL them
- 2. What they HOPED He would PERMIT: Enter the PIGS
- II. The AUTHORITY of the KING (Matt. 8:32)
 - A. The DEPARTURE of the demons
 - 1. ACCOMPLISHED by a SINGLE WORD
 - 2. EVIDENCED by the RESULT
 - B. The DESTRUCTION of the pigs
 - 1. Proved the MALICE of the DEMONS
 - 2. Proved the POWER of the KING
 - a. The ULTIMATE OWNER of ANIMALS
 - b. The SOVEREIGN MASTER of DEMONS
 - c. The MERCIFUL SAVIOR of HUMANS
- III. The ATTITUDE of the PEOPLE (Matt. 8:33-34)
 - A. The REPORT of the herdsmen
 - 1. What happened to the PIGS
 - 2. What happened to the MEN
 - B. The RESPONSE of the townsmen
 - 1. Came to MEET JESUS
 - 2. Implored Him to LEAVE
 - C. The REACTION of the Lord: He boarded a boat and LEFT
