Lessons:

- 1) Our worship must be constrained by God's Word and his instructions to us.
- 2) Crying out to God should never be our last resort.
- 3) We must be sensitive to hearing God's voice in the midst of trials and not just seek relief from whatever circumstances we are facing.
- 4) God being with us is enough!
- 5) Before we can effectively follow Christ, we must smash our idols.
- 6) God is faithful even when our faith is weak.
