## A QUESTION ABOUT FASTING (Matthew 9:14-17)

- I. The QUESTION (Matt. 9:14)
  - A. It was addressed to JESUS
  - B. It was asked by the DISCIPLES OF JOHN (cf. Mark 2:18; Lk. 5:33)
    - 1. It may have been rhetorical to CRITICIZE
    - 2. It may have been sincere to LEARN
  - C. It asked WHY they and the Pharisees FASTED and Jesus' disciples DID NOT
    - 1. OT required ONE annual fast
    - 2. Post-Exile Jews had added SEVERAL other fasts
    - 3. Pharisees' TRADITION scheduled fasts TWICE WEEKLY
- II. The ANSWER (Matt. 9:15)
  - A. One does not fast at a WEDDING CELEBRATION
    - 1. Jesus is the BRIDEGROOM
    - 2. His disciples are His ATTENDANTS
  - B. One fasts when in MOURNING
    - 1. There is coming a day when He will be "TAKEN AWAY"
    - 2. Then His DISCIPLES will FAST

- III. The ILLUSTRATIONS (Matt. 9:16-17)
  - A. PATCHING torn cloth (9:16)
    - 1. Cannot use NEW cloth to patch an OLD garment
    - 2. It would SHRINK and cause GREATER DAMAGE
  - B. REUSING old wine skins (9:17)
    - 1. Cannot refill them with NEW WINE
    - 2. SWELLING caused by fermentation would BURST the skin

## IV. The APPLICATION

- A. Jesus did NOT come to SET ASIDE the Law and INTRODUCE grace
  - 1. He came to FULFILL the LAW
  - 2. Salvation has ALWAYS BEEN by GRACE
- B. Jesus came to DISMANTLE their TRADITIONS
  - 1. His message was not CONNECTED to them
  - 2. His message could not be CONTAINED by them
  - 3. His message replaced their BONDAGE to RITUAL with the OBEDIENCE of FAITH
