## THE KING'S POWER OVER DEATH (Matthew 9:18-26)

- I. The King is ACCESSIBLE (Matt. 9:18)
  - A. Jesus was DINING with "TAX COLLECTORS and SINNERS"
  - B. Jesus was approached by an IMPORTANT JEW
    - 1. He was the CHIEF RULER of the synagogue (cf. Mk. 5:22; Lk 8:41)
    - 2. He was WEALTHY and INFLUENTIAL
    - 3. He was HUMBLE and DEFERENTIAL
  - C. Jesus was asked to RAISE the DEAD
    - 1. He came because of his DEEP NEED
    - 2. He came because of his DEEP FAITH
- II. The King is AVAILABLE (Matt. 9:19)
  - A. Jesus LEFT what He was doing
  - B. Jesus' "DISCIPLES" went with Him
- III. The King is COMPASSIONATE (Matt. 9:20-22; cf. Mk 5:24-34)
  - A. Jesus was accompanied by a CROWD
  - B. Jesus was TOUCHED by a WOMAN who was SICK
    - 1. Her BLEEDING made her UNCLEAN (Lev. 15:25-27)

- 2. She BELIEVED she could be HEALED by touching Jesus' CLOAK
- 3. Her INTENT was to be UNNOTICED
- C. Jesus responded with MERCY
  - 1. He STOPPED to ENCOURAGE her
  - 2. He HEALED her MALADY
  - 3. He SAVED her SOUL
- IV. The King is POWERFUL (Matt. 9:23-26)
  - A. Jesus encountered the MOURNERS
    - 1. Many would be TEARING their GARMENTS
    - 2. Many were WAILING in GRIEF
    - 3. Some were NOISILY playing FLUTES
  - B. Jesus DISRUPTED the "FUNERAL"
    - 1. He ORDERED them to "LEAVE" the house
    - 2. He announced the girl was ASLEEP
    - 3. The crowd LAUGHED at Jesus
  - C. He TOOK the DEAD girl's hand
  - D. He RESTORED the girl's LIFE
  - E. His miracle was PUBLICIZED
