- I. ANDREW: A FISHERMAN, Brother of SIMON PETER
 - A. What we KNOW about him
 - 1. A DISCIPLE of JOHN THE BAPTIST
 - 2. An EAGER WITNESS of Jesus (Jn 1:36-37)
 - a. Pointed his BROTHER to the Lord (Jn. 1:36-37)
 - b. Brought GENTILE enquirers to the Lord (Jn 12:20-22)
 - 3. A WILLING HELPER in the ministry (Jn 6:5-9)
 - B. What we can DEDUCE about him
 - 1. He possessed a SIMPLE but STRONG FAITH
 - 2. He was CONFIDENT and without PREJUDICE
 - 3. He was HUMBLE
 - C. What TRADITION/HISTORY says about him: Led the WIFE of a provincial GOVERNOR to Christ, for which he was CRUCIFIED
- II. JAMES the Son of Zebedee: A FISHERMAN, brother of JOHN
 - A. What we KNOW about him
 - 1. Called one of the "Sons of THUNDER" (Mk 3:17)

- 2. Suggested DESTROYING a town in Samaria with FIRE from HEAVEN (Lk 9:52-54)
- 3. Thought he deserved a PROMINENT place in the KINGDOM (Matt. 20:21-22)
- 4. First Apostle EXECUTED for his faith (Acts 12:1-3)
- B. What we can DEDUCE about him
 - 1. He was naturally FERVENT and AGGRESSIVE
 - 2. He became an ARDENT WITNESS
 - 3. He was perceived as PROMINENT among the Apostles
- C. What TRADITION/HISTORY says about him: Led to Christ the soldier GUARDING him, who was then BEHEADED with him
- III. JOHN: A FISHERMAN, brother of JAMES
 - A. What we KNOW about him (see above, also...)
 - 1. He REBUKED one ministering apart from THEM (Mk. 9:38)
 - 2. He was the first to BELIEVE in the RISEN Christ (Jn 20:8)
 - 3. He worked with PETER in founding the CHURCH
 - 4. He wrote FIVE BOOKS of the NT
 - B. What we can DEDUCE about him (see above, also...)
 - 1. He became known for his DEDICATION to TRUTH
 - 2. He became known for his DEMONSTRATION of LOVE
 - C. What TRADITION/HISTORY says about him: Spent his final years in EPHESUS training several church LEADERS
