 - 1. We KNOW the Father through His WORDS (Matt. 11:27; Luke 10:22; John 1:18; 15:15)
 - 2. We SEE the Father through His WORKS (John 10:32-38; 14:7; 15:24)
 - 3. We JOIN the Father through His POWER (John 6:39-40; 14:2-3; 1 Thess. 4:16-17)

II. He Came to DESTROY Satan's WORKS

- A. He came to DEFEAT Satan's PURPOSES (1 John 3:8; 1 Pet. 5:8-9)
- B. He came to DISARM Satan's POWER (Heb. 2:14-15)
- C. He came to DOOM Satan's PERSON (John 12:31; cf. Matt. 25:41)

III. He Came to DELIVER Men from WRATH

- A. He came to RESCUE us from SATAN (Luke 19:10; Col. 1:13)
- B. He came to REDEEM us from SIN (Col 1:14; 1 Tim. 1:15; 1 John 3:5)
- C. He came to RECONCILE us to the SOVEREIGN (Rom. 5:10; 2 Cor. 5:18; Col. 1:21-22)
- D. He came to RESERVE us for SALVATION (1 Thess. 5:9; Acts 4:12; Eph. 1:13; 1 Pet. 1:3-5; Rev. 12:10)
