THE KING'S MEN: PART 3 (Matthew 10:3a)

- I. Philip
 - A. What we KNOW about him: from Bethsaida
 - 1. The only Apostle known only by a GREEK name
 - 2. He was SEEKING the Messiah BEFORE meeting Jesus (Jn 1:45)
 - 3. Jesus FOUND him and said, "FOLLOW ME"
 - 4. Philip went to tell BARTHOLOMEW he'd found JESUS
 - 5. He was PRACTICAL and ANALYTICAL (Jn 6:5-7)
 - 6. He tended to be TIMID or INDECISIVE (Jn 12:20-22)
 - 7. He LACKED spiritual PERCEPTION (Jn 14:8)
 - B. What TRADITION/HISTORY says about him: Preached in Phrygia, martyred upside down by BLEEDING from wounds in his LEGS
- II. Bartholomew, Also Called Nathanael
 - A. What we KNOW about him: from CANA (John 1:45-51; 21:2)
 - 1. He was brought to Christ by PHILIP, his FRIEND
 - 2. He was a STUDENT of SCRIPTURE, and was WATCHING for Messiah
 - 3. He was affected by PREJUDICE

- 4. He was WILLING to INVESTIGATE
- 5. He was a man of INTEGRITY
- 6. He declared, "You are the SON of God, the KING of Israel"
- B. What TRADITION/HISTORY says about him: Preached in and around INDIA, martyred either by CRUCIFIXION or FLAYING
- III. Thomas, Also Called Didymus
 - A. What we KNOW about him
 - 1. He was PESSIMISTIC, but COURAGEOUS (Jn 11:14-16)
 - 2. His LOVE for Jesus was STEADFAST
 - 3. His DESIRE to be with Jesus was UNWAVERING (John 14:1-6)
 - 4. He did not BELIEVE the report of Jesus' resurrection
 - 5. Seeing Jesus, he exclaimed, "My LORD and my GOD!"
 - B. What TRADITION/HISTORY says about him: Preached in INDIA and died by being run through with a SPEAR
- IV. Matthew, also called Levi
 - A. What we KNOW about him (Matt. 9:9; Lk 5:28-29)
 - 1. He was a TAX-COLLECTOR in CAPERNAUM
 - 2. He forsook ALL when Jesus called him to FOLLOW
 - 3. He hosted a BANQUET to introduce Jesus to his FRIENDS
 - B. What TRADITION/HISTORY says about him: Preached in ARABIA and ETHIOPIA, where he EXECUTED with a sword
