THE PARABLE OF THE SEED AND THE SOILS (Matthew 13:3*b*-9, 18-23)

- I. The CONTENT of the Parable (Matt. 13:3*b*-9)
 - A. Begins with a call for ATTENTION (13:3b)
 - B. Emphasizes the SOWER sowing seed BROADLY (13:4-8)
 - 1. Some seed fell BESIDE the ROAD
 - a. Lay open on the SURFACE of the path
 - b. Quickly EATEN by the BIRDS
 - 2. Some seed fell on ROCKY places
 - a. Immediate SPROUTING and rapid GROWTH
 - b. No deep ROOTS to SUSTAIN the plant
 - 3. Some seed fell among THORNS
 - a. CHOKED by the thorns
 - b. Produced no CROP
 - 4. Some seed fell on GOOD SOIL and produced a CROP
 - C. Ends with a command to HEED His words (13:9)
- II. The MEANING of the Parable (Matt. 13:18-23)
 - A. The SOWER is not IDENTIFIED

- 1. On that day, the sower had been JESUS (cf. 13:37)
- 2. Later, the sowers would be the DISCIPLES
- B. The SEED is the "WORD of the KINGDOM"
 - 1. It is GOD who CREATES the SEED
 - 2. It is GOD who PRODUCES the HARVEST
- C. The UNRESPONSIVE hearers
 - 1. Their hearts are HARD
 - 2. The "EVIL ONE" quickly REMOVES the seed
- D. The SUPERFICIAL hearers
 - 1. They respond IMMEDIATELY and ENTHUSIASTICALLY
 - 2. The Word never PENETRATES their inner life to CHANGE them
 - 3. Their ROOTLESSNESS becomes evident when faced with AFFLICTION or PERSECUTION
 - 4. They depart IMMEDIATELY under PRESSURE
- E. The WORLDLY hearers
 - 1. Growth choked by DISTRACTIONS of the AGE
 - 2. Growth choked by DECEITFULNESS of WEALTH
 - 3. They are made UNFRUITFUL
- F. The BELIEVING hearers
 - 1. They UNDERSTAND the Word
 - 2. They PRODUCE fruit (cf. Gal. 5:22-23; Phil. 1:11)
