## TWO PARABLES ABOUT THE COMING JUDGMENT (Matthew 13:47-52)

- I. The WARNING of the JUDGMENT to Come (Matt. 13:47-50)
  - A. The Parable of the DRAGNET (13:47-48)
    - 1. "The KINDOM is LIKE a DRAGNET"
    - 2. It gathers FISH of EVERY KIND
    - 3. The CATCH is drawn to the BEACH
    - 4. The fishermen gather the GOOD FISH into CONTAINERS
    - 5. The fishermen THROW AWAY the BAD catch
  - B. The EXPLANATION of the parable (13:49-50)
    - 1. The parable will be FULFILLED at the END of the AGE
    - 2. The action will be PERFORMED by the ANGELS
      - a. Will begin with a WORLDWIDE GATHERING
      - b. Will involve a CAREFUL SORTING
      - c. Will result in REMOVAL of the WICKED
    - 3. The wicked will be cast into the "FURNACE of FIRE" to endure TORMENT
      - a. Hell is a place of UNRELENTING TORMENT

- b. Hell includes torment of both BODY and SOUL
- c. Hell's torments will be imposed in VARYING DEGREES
- d. Hell's torments will LAST FOREVER
- 4. The righteous will REMAIN in the KINGDOM
- II. The CALL to PROCLAIM the Warning (Matt. 13:51-52)
  - A. Jesus' QUESTION to the DISCIPLES (13:52)
    - 1. Asked if they UNDERSTOOD "ALL these things"
    - 2. They answered, "YES"
  - B. The Parable of the HOUSEHOLDER (13:53b)
    - 1. It describes those who are "like a HEAD of a HOUSEHOLD"
    - 2. He maintains a "TREASURY" of SUPPLIES for the household
    - 3. He takes from it "things NEW and OLD" to PROVIDE for the household
  - C. The parable APPLIES to "every SCRIBE who has BECOME a DISCIPLE of the kingdom of heaven" (13:53*a*)
    - 1. ALL who have become DISCIPLES of JESUS
    - 2. These disciples would be both WRITERS and TEACHERS
    - 3. They represent FURTHER TEACHERS who would follow them
