

THE GENERATIONS OF TERAH—GENEALOGICAL CHART  
(Genesis 11:10-32)

Shem	----	600 / 502

Nahor	193	148 / 341
Terah	222	205 / 427
Abram	292 (or 352) <sup>1</sup>	175 / 467 (or 527)
Isaac	392 (or 452)	180 / 562 (or 622)
Jacob/Esau	452 (or 512)	

Observations:

1. Noah may have been living when Abram WAS BORN
2. Shem was living when ISAAC was born, and possibly for the birth of JACOB and ESAU, and he may have been living when ABRAM DIED
3. Eber OUTLIVED Abram, and was living when JACOB and ESAU were born

<sup>1</sup> For those with alternate dates, the first date is based on the assumption that Abram was Terah's eldest, born when Terah was 70 (Gen. 11:26). The second date is if he was born 60 years later to reconcile his leaving Haran at age 75 (Gen. 12:4) after Terah died at age 205 (Gen. 11:32; cf. Acts 7:4).
