THE KING IS REJECTED BY THE REGIONAL RULER (Matthew 14:1-13)

- I. Herod's EXECUTION of JOHN THE BAPTIST (Matt. 14:3-12)
 - A. John was a RIGHTEOUS PROPHET (14:3*a*)
 - 1. Message was a call to REPENT and prepare for the KING (cf. 3:2)
 - 2. General response had been overwhelmingly POSITIVE (cf. 3:5)
 - 3. Ministry characterized by FEARLESS CONFRONTATION (cf. 3:7)
 - B. Herod was a WICKED DESPOT (14:3b-4; cf. 4:12)
 - 1. He ARRESTED John for his presumption
 - 2. He wanted to KILL him, but FEARED the CROWD
 - C. Herodias was an EVIL MANIPULATOR
 - 1. She took advantage of Herod's BIRTHDAY
 - 2. She had her DAUGHTER dance for the REVELERS
 - 3. Herod made a FOOLISH PROMISE (cf. Mk. 6:23)
 - 4. Salome demanded the HEAD of John the Baptist
 - 5. Herod sent for JOHN'S HEAD
 - 6. He gave it to Salome, who TOOK it to HER MOTHER

- D. John's disciples treated his BODY with RESPECT
 - 1. They BURIED his BODY
 - 2. They "REPORTED to JESUS"
- II. Herod's CONCLUSION about JESUS (Matt. 14:1-2)
 - A. Herod "HEARD the NEWS about Jesus"
 - 1. It was "at THAT TIME"
 - 2. He heard of Jesus' MIRACULOUS POWERS
 - B. Herod concluded that JOHN had RISEN from the DEAD
- III. Jesus' REACTION to HEROD (Matt. 14:13)
 - A. Jesus LEFT by BOAT
 - B. He went to a "SECLUDED place by HIMSELF"
