THE COVENANT CONFIRMED (Genesis 15:1-21)

- I. A General ASSURANCE (Gen. 15:1)
 - A. The TIME--"After THESE THINGS"
 - 1. Achieving VICTORY over the ARMIES of Chedorlaomer
 - 2. Receiving BLESSING from Melchizedek
 - 3. Paying TITHES to Melchizedek
 - 4. Refusing REWARD from SODOM
 - B. The MANNER
 - 1. Received "The WORD of the LORD"
 - 2. Received a VISION while AWAKE and ACTIVE
 - C. The MESSAGE
 - 1. CALLED Abram by NAME
 - 2. CAUTIONED Abram against FEAR
 - 3. ASSURED him of SECURITY
- II. A Particular PROMISE (Gen. 15:2-11)
 - A. Includes numerous OFFSPRING (15:2-6)
 - 1. Would have HIS OWN SEED

- 2. Would be RECEIVED by FAITH (cf. Rom. 4:3; Gal. 3:6; Jms. 2:23)
 - a. Noah: GRACE, then righteousness (6:8-9), emphasis on GOD'S SOVEREIGNTY
 - Abram: FAITH, then righteousness, emphasis on MAN'S
 RESPONSIBILITY (cf. Eph. 2:8-9; Jn. 6:37)
- B. Includes the LAND of Canaan (15:7-11)
 - 1. Promised as a POSSESSION
 - 2. Commanded a SACRIFICE
- III. The COVENANT of God (Gen. 15:12-21)
 - A. A detailed PROPHECY (15:12-16)
 - 1. AFFLICTION of Abram's seed
 - 2. JUDGMENT of ENEMIES of Abram's seed
 - 3. DELIVERANCE of Abram's seed from BONDAGE
 - 4. SETTLEMENT of Abram's seed in the LAND
 - B. Based on God's AUTHORITY (15:17)
 - 1. God is the BENEFACTOR (cf. Exo. 13:21)
 - a. "SMOKING oven" depicts God's righteous WRATH
 - b. "FLAMING torch" depicts God's gracious GUIDANCE
 - 2. Abram is the BENEFICIARY
 - C. Repeated for CLARITY and EMPHASIS (15:18-21)
