THE BLIND WHO WILL NEVER SEE (Matthew 16:1-4)

- I. Jesus' Critics DEMONSTRATE Their Blindness (Matt. 16:1)
 - A. They SOUGHT the DARKNESS (16:1*a*)
 - 1. The Pharisees practiced RITUAL and prioritized TRADITION
 - 2. The Sadducees denied the SPIRITUAL and prioritized EXPEDIENCY
 - 3. These ADVERSARIES were UNITED against CHRIST
 - B. They CURSED the LIGHT (16:1*b*; cf. Jn 3:19-21)
 - 1. They came to TEST Jesus
 - 2. They requested a SIGN from HEAVEN (cf. 12:38)
- II. Jesus REVEALS Their Blindness (Matt. 16:2-3)
 - A. They VALUED the TRIVIAL (16:2-3*a*)
 - 1. They paid CLOSE attention to the WEATHER
 - 2. They could PREDICT when it would be FAIR or FOUL
 - B. They were OBLIVIOUS to the SPIRITUAL (16:3b)
 - 1. They could not DISCERN the PRESENCE of MESSIAH
 - 2. They could not PERCEIVE the coming JUDGMENT

- III. Jesus REBUKES Their Blindness (Matt. 16:4*a*; cf. 12:39-42)
 - A. They were "an EVIL and ADULTEROUS generation"
 - 1. He knew their HYPOCRISY
 - 2. He knew their IDOLATRY
 - B. He would NOT PROVIDE the sign they REQUESTED
 - 1. They were REJECTING the WORD from God
 - 2. They could not AVERT the coming JUDGMENT
 - 3. They would not BELIEVE in Jesus' RESURRECTION
- IV. Jesus ABANDONS Them to their Blindness (Matt. 16:4*b*)
 - A. Jesus left THEM
 - 1. He will spend little time with CROWDS or RELIGIOUS leaders
 - 2. He provides no more ARGUMENTS or EVIDENCE to UNBELIEVERS
 - B. Jesus left THE REGION
 - 1. He withdraws to focus on TRAINING His DISCIPLES
 - 2. He provides ADDITIONAL teaching to those who BELIEVE
