OFFENDING CHRIST (Matthew 16:21-23)

- I. The PLAN of God (Matt. 16:21)
 - A. Transition to greater CLARITY
 - 1. They had AFFIRMED that He is the CHRIST (16:16)
 - 2. He begins to REVEAL what is COMING
 - B. Statement of a divine IMPERATIVE: "MUST"
 - C. Revelation of the divine PROGRAM
 - 1. He must GO to JERUSALEM
 - 2. He must SUFFER at the hands of JEWISH leaders
 - 3. He must be MURDERED
 - 4. He must be RAISED UP on the third day
- II. The PRESUMPTION of Peter (Matt. 16:22)
 - A. Desire for PRIVACY
 - 1. This indicates Jesus' HUMANITY
 - 2. This was an act of a FRIEND
 - B. Statement of REBUKE
 - 1. He was the acknowledged LEADER of the APOSTLES (16:19)

- 2. He assumed he now SPOKE for GOD (16:17)
- 3. He DENIED the TRUTH of Jesus' statement
- III. The PROTEST of Christ (Matt. 16:23*a*)
 - A. Sharp RETORT: "Get BEHIND Me"
 - 1. Could mean, "REMEMBER your PLACE"
 - 2. Probably means, "GET OUT of My WAY"
 - A. Stinging DENUNCIATION: "SATAN"
 - 1. It was a REMINDER of His temptation (cf. 4:10)
 - 2. It was a REPETITION of His temptation (cf. Lk 4:13)
 - 3. Peter had just SPOKEN for SATAN
 - B. New MEANING of an earlier METAPHOR
 - 1. He had called Peter a ROCK upon which Jesus would BUILD
 - 2. He had become a ROCK over which Jesus might STUMBLE
- IV. The PRINCIPLES for US (Matt. 16:23*b*)
 - A. Beware a focus on HUMAN INTERESTS
 - B. Maintain a focus on GOD'S INTERESTS
 - 1. God's plan of SALVATION conflicts with man's EXPECTATION
 - 2. God's means of REFINING us involves SUFFERING
