## HUMBLE TRUST IN THE KINGDOM (Matthew 17:22 - 18:4)

- I. MODELED in the Character of Its KING (Matt. 17:22-27)
  - A. In His DEATH and RESURRECTION (17:22-23, cf. Acts 2:22-23)
    - 1. He submitted to the EVIL plan of His CREATURES
      - a. Willing to be BETRAYED
      - b. Willing to be KILLED
    - 2. He submitted to the RIGHTEOUS plan of His FATHER
      - a. Willing to be the GRACIOUS SACRIFICE
      - b. Willing to be the RISEN LORD
    - 3. The disciples were "DEEPLY GRIEVED" (cf. Mk. 9:32)
  - B. In His PAYMENT of the TEMPLE TAX (17:24-27)
    - 1. Peter was CHALLENGED by the COLLECTORS (vv. 24-25*a*)
    - 2. Jesus EXPLAINED the PRINCIPLE (vv. 25*b*-27*a*)
      - a. Taxes are not LEVIED on a king's SON
      - b. As the Son of GOD, He's EXEMPT from the TEMPLE tax (cf. 12:1-8; 26)
      - c. As ADOPTED SONS of God, so are His DISCIPLES (cf. 5:9)

- 3. He PAYED the tax to not cause others to STUMBLE (v. 27b)
- 4. He PROVIDED the payment MIRACULOUSLY
- II. DEMANDED in the Character of Its CITIZENS (Matt. 18:1-4)
  - A. The SETTING (18:1-2)
    - 1. His disciples entered "AT THAT TIME"
    - 2. They asked which of THEM would be GREATEST in the kingdom of HEAVEN (18:1; cf. Lk. 9:46)
    - 3. Jesus called a CHILD to be an EXAMPLE
  - B. The LESSON (18:3-4)
    - 1. They had to "BECOME like CHILDREN"
      - a. Required that they CHANGE
      - b. Necessary to ENTER the kingdom
    - 2. The quality demanded was childlike HUMILITY
      - a. Demonstrated by CONFIDENT TRUST
      - b. Demonstrated by UNCONCERN for STATUS
    - 3. "Greatness" is evaluated by ATTITUDE, not POSITION
      - a. Cannot be ACHIEVED by AMBITION
      - b. Can only be ACKNOWLEDGED by the KING
