HOW TO OBTAIN ETERNAL LIFE (Matthew 19:16-22)

- I. An IMPORTANT Question (Matt. 19:16)
 - A. The questioner was WEALTHY (v. 22), YOUNG (v. 20), and INFLUENTIAL (Lk. 18:18)
 - B. His concern was URGENT and SINCERE (Mk. 10:17)
 - C. He desired to "obtain ETERNAL LIFE"
 - 1. He knew he NEEDED it
 - 2. He came to JESUS to FIND it
- II. A SURPRISING Response (Matt. 19:17-19)
 - A. Jesus asked "Why ask ME what is GOOD?," adding, "There is only ONE who is GOOD"
 - B. Jesus said, "KEEP the COMMANDMENTS"
 - 1. The man asked for CLARIFICATION
 - 2. Jesus listed commandments SIX, SEVEN, EIGHT, NINE, and FIVE, and added "love your NEIGHBOR as YOURSELF (Exod. 5:20; Lev. 19:18)
- III. An INSIGHTFUL Admission (Matt. 19:20)
 - A. The man CLAIMED to have KEPT "all these things"

- B. He admitted he was "STILL LACKING"
 - 1. The Law is not a GOAL for man's ACHIEVEMENT
 - 2. It is a PICTURE of God's PERFECTION
- IV. A CHALLENGING Instruction (Matt. 19:21)
 - A. Jesus acknowledged the man was still INCOMPLETE
 - B. He told Him to PRIORITIZE having treasure in HEAVEN
 - 1. He must SELL his POSSESSIONS
 - 2. He must GIVE the proceeds to the POOR
 - 3. He must COMMIT himself to FOLLOWING Jesus
- V. A TRAGIC Conclusion (Matt. 19:22)
 - A. He considered his PROPERTY more VALUABLE than ETERNAL LIFE
 - B. Stricken with GRIEF, the man LEFT
 - 1. He GRIEVED the COMMITMENT required
 - 2. He REFUSED to FOLLOW Jesus
 - C. Salvation requires ADMITTING one's GUILT
 - 1. One must FORSAKE SELF
 - 2. One must FOLLOW CHRIST (cf. **16:24-26**)
