## CHRIST IS RISEN! (1 Corinthians 15:1-23)

## I. The EVIDENCE of Christ's Resurrection

- A. His APPEARANCES after His Resurrection
  - 1. To MARY MAGDALENE and other WOMEN (Mt. 28:8-10; Mk. 16:9-10; Jn. 20:11-18)
  - 2. To PETER (Lk. 24:34; 1 Cor. 15:5)
  - 3. To the DISCIPLES on the Emmaus Road (Mk. 16:12)
  - 4. To the DISCIPLES without THOMAS in the Upper Room (Jn. 20:19-25)
  - 5. To the DISCIPLES with THOMAS the next SUNDAY (Jn. 20:26-29)
  - 6. To SEVEN disciples by the SEA OF GALILEE (Jn. 21:1-24)
  - To the APOSTLES and more than 500 believers, including Jesus' half-brother JAMES (1 Cor. 15:6-7)
  - 8. To those who witnessed the ASCENSION (Acts 1:3-12)
- B. EFFECTS which must have a CAUSE
  - 1. The TOMB was EMPTY (Jn. 20:1-10)
  - 2. The CHURCH was ESTABLISHED (Acts 2:33)
  - 3. The DAY of worship was CHANGED (Acts 20:7)
  - 4. The DISCIPLES went from being FRIGHTENED and CONFUSED to being FEARLESS and CONVINCING

- II. The RESULTS of Christ's Resurrection
  - A RESURRECTION BODY, which was a prototype of our own RESURRECTION BODIES (1 Cor. 15:35-41)
    - 1. Not necessarily DIFFERENT, but more evidently INCORRUPTIBLE
    - 2. Related to the NATURAL but SUPERIOR
  - B. A PROOF of His CLAIMS (Rom. 1:4)
    - 1. DIVINITY
    - 2. AUTHORITY
    - 3. POWER
  - C. A prerequisite to all His subsequent MINISTRIES (Rom. 6:9-10)
    - 1. DELIVERER (1 Pet. 3:18-22)
    - 2. INTERCESSOR (Heb. 7:24-25)
    - 3. JUDGE (2 Cor. 5:10; Rev. 20:11-12)
- III. The IMPORTANCE of Christ's Resurrection
  - A. It AUTHENTICATES Jesus as a true PROPHET (Mt. 20:19; 28:6)
  - B. It PERMITS Jesus' post-resurrection ministries, enabling VICTORY over SIN and DEATH (Rom. 6:1-10; Gal. 2:20)
  - C. It COMPLETES the GOSPEL message (1 Cor. 15:3-8; Rom. 4:25)
  - D. It VALIDATES our WITNESS (1 Cor. 15:13-18)
  - E. It ESTABLISHES our HOPE (1 Cor. 15:19-20)
