JACOB'S WORSHIP (Genesis 27:41 – 28:22)

- I. Rebekah's FEAR (Gen. 27:41-46)
 - A. Heard of Esau's plan to MURDER Jacob when Isaac DIED
 - B. Told Jacob to go to Laban for "a FEW DAYS"
 - C. Asked Isaac to SEND Jacob to Haran for a WIFE
- II. Isaac's FAITH (Gen. 28:1-5)
 - A. COMMANDED Jacob to find an APPROPRIATE wife
 - B. INVOKED God's BLESSING
 - 1. RESTATEMENT of the earlier blessing
 - 2. Specifically, the blessing God had promised to ABRAHAM and to ISAAC
 - 3. Indicative of Isaac's REPENTANCE
 - C. Sent him away with NOTHING
- III. Esau's FOLLY (Gen. 28:6-9)
 - A. Recognized his father's REPENTANCE
 - 1. His full APPROVAL of JACOB
 - 2. His DISAPPOINTMENT in ESAU
 - B. Recognized Jacob's OBEDIENCE
 - C. He MARRIED a daughter of ISHMAEL
 - 1. Attempting to REGAIN Isaac's FAVOR
 - 2. Demonstrating SPIRITUAL BLINDNESS

- IV. Jacob's FUTURE (Gen. 28:10-15)
 - A. Traveled toward Haran in OBEDIENCE to his PARENTS
 - B. Camped in BETHEL
 - 1. Seemingly by RANDOM CHANCE
 - 2. The place ABRAHAM built his first ALTAR
 - C. Heard from GOD in a DREAM
 - 1. Saw a STAIRWAY from EARTH to HEAVEN
 - 2. Heard the LORD SPEAK
 - a. Confirmed the COVENANT to JACOB
 - b. Promised present PROTECTION and PROVISION
- V. Jacob's FAITH (Gen. 28:16-22)
 - A. Recognizes the PRESENCE of the LORD
 - B. Builds an ALTAR to WORSHIP God
 - 1. Made an OFFERING
 - 2. Named the place BETHEL, meaning "the HOUSE of GOD"
 - C. Made a VOW to GOD
 - 1. Based on God's PROMISE of BLESSING
 - 2. Promised his own FAITHFULNESS to GOD
 - 3. Promised a TITHE of all God's BLESSING
- VI. Lessons
 - A. The importance of MARRYING a BELIEVER
 - B. TITHING is based on the principle of God's OWNERSHIP of ALL
 - C. We can trust God to direct our STEPS and lead us in His WILL
