 - A. Jacob's DESIRE to LEAVE (Gen. 30:25-28)
 - 1. He had FULFILLED his OBLIGATION
 - 2. Laban wanted him to STAY
 - B. Jacob's TERMS for STAYING (Gen. 30:29-34)
 - 1. Would take NOTHING that then EXISTED
 - 2. He would keep only DISCOLORED offspring
 - C. Laban's SECURITY measures (Gen. 30:35-36)
 - 1. Removed the discolored livestock HIMSELF
 - 2. Pastured the MARRED flock at a THREE DAYS' journey from the PURE flock under Jacob's care
