THE BARREN FIG TREE (Matthew 21:18-22)

- I. ANTICIPATION (Matt. 21:18-19*a*)
 - A. The SETTING
 - 1. It was MORNING
 - 2. Jesus was RETURNING to JERUSALEM
 - 3. He "became HUNGRY"
 - B. The FIG TREE
 - 1. It was by ITSELF along the ROAD
 - 2. It was "in LEAF" but had NO FIGS (Mk. 11:13)
- II. DENUNCIATION (Matt. 21:19b)
 - A. Jesus REBUKED the TREE for having NO FRUIT
 - B. He announced it would NEVER AGAIN BEAR FRUIT
 - C. The tree WITHERED and DIED
- III. APPLICATION (Matt. 21:20-22)
 - A. Explicit in the TEXT
 - The disciples were AMAZED that the tree had WITHERED so QUICKLY

- 2. Jesus explained the POWER of BELIEVING faith (cf. 17:20)
 - a. NOT faith in THEMSELVES
 - b. NOT faith in FAITH
 - c. NOT simply confidence that God will ANSWER
 - d. INCLUDES belief in God as the OMNIPOTENT CREATOR
 - e. INCLUDES belief in Christ as REDEEMING SAVIOR
 - f. INCLUDES belief in the Bible as God's REVEALED WORD
- B. Implicit in the CONTEXT (cf. Mk. 11:11-24)
 - 1. By cleansing the temple, Jesus denounced their WORSHIP (21:12-13)
 - a. They PERFORMED the RITUALS
 - b. They PERVERTED them for PROFIT
 - 2. By cursing the fig tree, Jesus denounced their NATION (cf. Hos. 9:10; Nah. 3:12; Zech. 3:10)
 - a. They put on a SHOW of PIETY
 - b. They produced no FRUIT of RIGHTEOUSNESS
 - 3. Jesus' DESTRUCTION of the tree symbolized His coming JUDGMENT for Israel's HYPOCRISY
