## WHOSE SON IS THE CHRIST? (Matthew 22:41-46)

- I. Jesus' Question for the PHARISEES (Matt. 22:41-42*a*)
  - A. He was still TEACHING in the TEMPLE (Mt. 21:23 24:21)
    - 1. CROWDS were LISTENING (Mk 12:35-37; Lk 20:41-44)
    - 2. The PHARISEES were LURKING (cf. Mt. 22:34-46)
  - B. He asked them a TWO-PART question
    - 1. "What do YOU THINK about the Christ?"
    - 2. "WHOSE SON is he?"
- II. The Pharisees' ORTHODOX Answer (Matt. 22:42*b*)
  - A. "He is the SON of DAVID" (2 Sam. 7:12-16; Ps. 89)
    - 1. Who will OCCUPY David's throne (2 Sam. 7:12)
    - 2. Who will RESTORE the throne from RUINS (Amos 9:11)
    - Who will ESTABLISH and MAINTAIN it FOREVER (2 Sam. 7:16; Ps. 89:29; Ezek. 37:21-25)
  - B. They had OBJECTED to Jesus' ACCEPTANCE of this title
    - 1. They never CHALLENGED His DESCENT from DAVID

- 2. They REFUSED to admit He COULD BE the Christ
- III. Jesus' FOLLOW-UP Question (Matt. 22:43-45)
  - A. "Then how does DAVID ... call Him 'LORD'?" (cf. Ps. 110:1)
    - Affirms David's words were INSPIRED by the HOLY SPIRIT (Mk. 12:36)
    - 2. Indicates YHWY promised the Son of David the ETERNAL throne, seated at His RIGHT HAND
  - B. "If David calls Him 'LORD,' how is He his SON?"
    - 1. RECOGNIZE the necessary DEITY of the Christ
    - 2. ADMIT that Jesus is the SON of GOD
- IV. The Pharisees' SILENCE (Matt. 22:46)
  - A. They were UNABLE to ANSWER
  - B. They were UNWILLING to ASK another question
