## THE SIGNS OF CHRIST'S COMING, PART 2: OVERVIEW OF "THE BIRTH PAINS" (Matthew 24:4-14)

- I. Varied INTERPRETATIONS of the Olivet Discourse
  - A. That it WAS FULFILLED with Rome's destruction of JERUSALEM in AD 70
    - 1. Requires NEARLY EVERYTHING to be FIGURATIVE
    - 2. Concludes that the KINGDOM ERA is NOW
  - B. That it IS BEING FULFILLED during the CHURCH AGE
    - 1. Requires MANY DETAILS to be FIGURATIVE
    - Concludes that the CHURCH will BRING IN the Kingdom through world EVANGELISM
  - C. That it WILL BE FULFILLED during the TRIBULATION after the CHURCH has been REMOVED
    - 1. Sees it as addressed to the JEWS, not the CHURCH
    - 2. Treats NEARLY EVERYTHING as LITERAL
    - 3. Concludes that CHRIST will ESTABLISH the Kingdom SUDDENLY...
      - a. He will DESTROY the kingdom of ANTICHRIST
      - b. He will RESCUE the surviving CONVERTS
      - c. He will RULE from JERUSALEM

- II. Evidences Supporting a DISTANT FUTURE Fulfillment
  - A. The SIGNS are compared to BIRTH PAINS (24:4-14)
    - 1. They BEGIN just BEFORE the birth
    - 2. They are a NECESSARY part of the birth PROCESS
    - 3. They come with increasing FREQUENCY and SEVERITY as the birth APPROACHES
  - B. The ones "SAVED" are those who "ENDURE" to the "END" (24:13-14)
    - 1. Probably not those still BELIEVING when they DIE
    - 2. But the BELIEVERS who SURVIVE to enter the KINGDOM when Christ RETURNS
  - C. The gospel will be proclaimed in "the WHOLE WORLD" (24:14)
  - D. The "ABOMINATION of DESOLATION" will appear (24:15; cf. Dan. 9:27; 11:31; 12:11)
  - E. There will be a period of great TRIBULATION of unprecedented SCOPE and SEVERITY (24:21; cf. Dan. 12:1-2)
  - F. That will be followed by spectacular CELESTIAL DISTRUBANCES (24:29-30; cf. Isa. 13:6-13; Rev. 6:13-14)
  - G. ALL these things will be experienced by a SINGLE GENERATION (24:32-35)
