## JUDAH'S LINE (Genesis 38:1-30)

- I. Judah's SONS (Gen. 38:1-11)
  - A. Their BIRTH (38:1-5)
    - 1. Judah's SEPARATION from his BROTHERS
    - 2. Judah's MARRIAGE to a CANAANITE
    - 3. Judah's SONS: Er, Onan, Shelah
  - B. Their BRIDE (38:6-11)
    - 1. Judah's SELECTION of a WIFE for Er: Tamar
    - 2. God's EXECUTION of Er for WICKEDNESS
    - 3. God's EXECUTION of Onan for WICKEDNESS
    - 4. Judah's UNJUST treatment of Tamar
      - a. Sent her back to her FATHER in SHAME
      - b. Reneged on his PROMISE to her
- II. Judah's SHAME (Gen. 38:12-26)
  - A. Judah's CONDITION
    - 1. Recently became a WIDOWER
    - 2. Participating in the SHEEP-SHEARING FESTIVAL
  - B. Tamar's COMPROMISE

- 1. Posed as a TEMPLE PROSTITUTE
- 2. HIRED by JUDAH
- 3. Returned to her FATHER'S HOUSE
- C. Judah's CONFUSION
  - 1. Sent PAYMENT in exchange for the PLEDGE
  - 2. Unable to LOCATE the one he had HIRED
- D. Judah's CONFESSION
  - 1. Demanded Tamar's EXECUTION for UNFAITHFULNESS
  - 2. Was revealed as the FATHER of her CHILD
  - CONFESSED and FORSOOK his SINS
    - a. Breach of PROMISE
    - b. FORNICATION
  - 4. Showed Tamar MERCY and COMPASSION
- III. Judah's SEED (Gen. 38:27-30)
  - A. Tamar's PROGENY: Zerah and Perez
  - B. Tamar's POSTERITY: DAVID and JESUS (cf. Matt. 1:1-6, esp. v. 3)
    - Provides IRONIC twist to the Jews' protest, "WE are not born of FORNICATION" (John 8:41)
    - Shows that Jesus is who He is because of His INHERENT NATURE as God,
      not His INHERITED CHARACTER of His forebears
    - 3. Proves that God's CHOICE is of GRACE
    - 4. Displays God's FORGIVENESS when a sinner REPENTS
