THE SIGNS OF CHRIST'S COMING, PART 7: THE FINAL GENERATION (Matthew 24:32-35)

I. The "PARABLE" of the FIG TREE (Matt. 24:32)

- A. It is not a COMPLICATED ALLEGORY
 - 1. The FIG TREE does not represent ISRAEL
 - 2. The BUDS do not represent its RE-ESTABLISHMENT in 1948
- B. It is a SIMPLE ANALOGY
 - 1. In SPRING its branches become TENDER and BUD
 - 2. That indicates that SUMMER is NEAR
 - 3. You can expect a HARVEST in a SHORT TIME
- II. The APPLICATION of the "Parable" (Matt. 24:33-34)
 - A. It is parallel to seeing "ALL THESE THINGS"
 - B. These events SIGNAL that He IS NEAR
 - C. "This GENERATION will not pass away UNTIL all these things TAKE PLACE"
 - 1. Cannot refer to the DISCIPLES' generation
 - a. Too much DID NOT OCCUR in AD 70

- Jesus did not make a BAD GUESS because He didn't KNOW
 FOR SURE (see v. 36)
- 2. Cannot refer to the JEWS in general
- 3. Cannot refer to the CHRIST REJECTORS in general
- 4. Can refer only to those STILL LIVING to witness the SIGNS
 - a. Probably does not apply to the CHURCH, with the RAPTURE at the CLOSE of the Tribulation
 - b. It applies to TRIBULATION converts only, with the RAPTURE of the church PRECEDING the Tribulation
- III. The Inevitable PASSING of HEAVEN and EARTH (Matt. 24:35*a*; cf. 5:18; Lk 16:17)
- IV. The Infallible ENDURING of Jesus' WORDS (Matt. 24:35*b*)
