Genesis 57

RECONCILIATION AND REVIVAL (Genesis 45:1-28)

- I. Joseph's REVELATION of His IDENTITY (Gen. 45:1-3)
 - A. He was OVERCOME by Judah's SELFLESS offer (cf. 42:32-34)
 - B. He ordered everyone but his BROTHERS to LEAVE
 - C. He TOLD his brothers WHO HE WAS
 - 1. He WEPT so loudly that the EGYPTIANS HEARD
 - 2. His brothers were TERRIFIED
- II. Joseph's RESTORATION of His BROTHERS (Gen. 45:4-15)
 - A. He explained events from GOD'S PERSPECTIVE (45:4-8)
 - 1. GOD had SENT him to Egypt
 - 2. GOD had PRESERVED him in Egypt
 - 3. GOD had EXALTED him in Egypt
 - 4. GOD had PREPARED him to DELIVER both EGYPT and ISRAEL
 - B. He invited them to MOVE to Egypt (45:9-15)
 - 1. Jacob needed to KNOW his SON was ALIVE
 - 2. Jacob needed to BRING the FAMILY to EGYPT
 - a. To be NEAR JOSEPH
 - b. To SURVIVE the YEARS of FAMINE yet to come

3. Their FELLOWSHIP was RESTORED

- III. Joseph's RECLAMATION OF His HERITAGE (Gen. 45:16-28)
 - A. Pharaoh HONORED Joseph's FAMILY (45:16-20)
 - 1. He ordered them to COME to EGYPT
 - 2. He promised them the "FAT of the LAND"
 - 3. He provided WAGONS for their TRANSPORTATION
 - 4. He promised GOODS for their HOUSEHOLDS
 - B. Joseph PROVIDED for their MOVE (45:21-24)
 - 1. He gave them PROVISION for the JOURNEY
 - 2. He gave SPECIAL GIFTS for EACH
 - 3. He admonished them not to QUARREL on the WAY
 - C. The brothers CONFESSED to their FATHER (45:25-28)
 - They told him Joseph was ALIVE and RULING EGYPT, and he responded with STUNNED UNBELIEF
 - 2. They told him "ALL the WORDS of JOSEPH," and his SPIRIT REVIVED
 - 3. Then he BELIEVED and agreed to GO
