THE FORGOTTEN MAN AT CHRISTMAS: JOSEPH

(Matthew 1:18-2:23)

- 1. His PERSON
 - A. He was a GODLY man (Matt. 1:18-19)
 - Discovered Mary's PREGNANCY in the midst of their BETROTHAL period
 - 2. Decided on a quiet DIVORCE after careful DELIBERATION
 - a. Demonstrated RIGHTEOUSNESS—unwilling to marry an IMPURE woman
 - b. Demonstrated MERCY—unwilling to have Mary EXECUTED for FORNICATION
 - c. Demonstrated LOVE—unwilling to subject Mary to PUBLIC DISGRACE
 - B. He was an OBEDIENT man (Matt. 1:20-25)
 - Received a message in a DREAM from an ANGEL
 - a. Called Joseph "son of DAVID"
 - b. Told Joseph to MARRY his betrothed
 - c. Told Joseph to NAME the child JESUS
 - 2. Responded in FAITH and OBEDIENCE

II. His PARENTING

- A. During Jesus' INFANCY (Matt. 2:1-15)
 - 1. Relocated the family to BETHLEHEM
 - 2. Received a WARNING in a dream to move to EGYPT
 - 3. Responded in FAITH and OBEDIENCE
- B. During Jesus' CHILDHOOD and BEYOND (Matt. 2:19-21)
 - 1. Persevered in OBEYING God's INSTRUCTIONS
 - a. Summoned in a dream to RETURN to ISRAEL
 - b. Cautioned in a dream to AVOID JUDEA
 - 2. Provided for Jesus a GODLY training (Luke 2:51-52)
 - 3. Prepared Jesus for SKILLED LABOR (Mark 6:3)

III. His PRIORITIES

- A. He BELIEVED GOD enough to risk forfeiting all other RELATIONSHIPS
 - 1. Took Mary as his WIFE
 - 2. Reared a child NOT HIS OWN
- B. He BELIEVED GOD enough to ORDER his LIFE around JESUS
