 - a. She had LET him through the GATE
 - b. She declared "You too were WITH JESUS"
 - 3. Denied the LORD
 - a. He said, "I neither KNOW nor UNDERSTAND what you are TALKING ABOUT"
 - b. He WITHDREW to the GATEWAY/PORTICO
 - B. Second Denial (26:70-72)

- 1. Identified AGAIN by the SERVANT-GIRL
- 2. Confronted by OTHERS
- 3. Continued to DENY the Lord, this time with an OATH
- C. Third Denial (26:73-74*a*)
 - 1. Confronted AGAIN by those standing in the COURTYARD
 - 2. Identified as a native of GALILEE
 - 4. Denied Christ FORCEFULLY
 - a. Called down CURSES upon himself if he were LYING
 - b. Took a solemn OATH that he spoke the TRUTH
 - c. Declared, "I DO NOT KNOW the man!"

 - A. HEARD the rooster CROW
 - B. REMEMBERED the WORDS of Jesus
 - C. WEPT in broken-hearted REPENTANCE
 - 1. A word of CAUTION: If an APOSTLE could deny Christ, ANYONE could
 - 2. A word of COMFORT: When we fail, the way is open for REPENTANCE, FORGIVENESS, and RESTORATION
