- I. The SPEAKER (Rev. 1:9*a*)
  - A. He identifies himself as "I, JOHN" (cf. 21:2; 22:8)
  - B. He describes himself as their BROTHER and FELLOW PARTAKER
    - 1. Sharing their TRIBULATION
    - 2. Sharing their EXPECTATION
- II. The SETTING (Rev. 1:9*b*-11)
  - A. He was in the isle of Patmos, "because of the WORD of God and the TESTIMONY of Jesus (1:9*b*)
  - B. He was in the SPIRIT on the "LORD'S DAY" (1:10*a*)
    - 1. A transportation of spirit to receive a special MESSAGE
    - 2. A transportation through TIME to the "Day of the Lord"?
    - 3. An experience during WORSHIP on the 1ST day of the WEEK?
  - C. He heard a voice LIKE a TRUMPET (1:10*b*-11)
    - 1. Christ SPEAKS (cf. 1:8, 17-18)
    - 2. John must WRITE
    - 3. The CHURCHES must READ
- III. The SCENE (Rev. 1:12-16)
  - A. He saw SEVEN golden LAMPSTANDS
  - B. He saw "one like a SON of MAN"
    - 1. Standing in the MIDDLE of the lampstands: AUTHORITY
    - 2. Clothed like a PRIEST and JUDGE: DIGNITY
    - 3. Hair WHITE as snow: PURITY and ETERNITY
    - 4. Eyes LIKE FLAMES (cf. 19:12): RIGHTEOUSNESS and KNOWLEDGE
    - 5. Feet like burnished BRONZE: JUDGMENT

- 6. Voice like the sound of MANY WATERS: OMNIPOTENCE
- 7. Holding seven STARS in his right hand: SOVEREIGNTY
- 8. Sending a sharp, two-edged SWORD from his mouth: WRATH
- 9. Face SHINING like the SUN: MAJESTY

## IV. The SAVIOR (Rev. 1:17-18)

- A. John COLLAPSED as though DEAD
- B. Christ REVIVED and ENCOURAGED him
  - 1. Christ IS ETERNAL
    - a. The EVER-LIVING One
    - b. The One who BECAME DEAD
    - c. The One who lives "unto the AGES of the AGES"
  - 2. Christ RULES ETERNITY
    - a. Controlling DEATH
    - b. Controlling DESTINY
- V. The SCRIBE (Rev. 1:19-20)
  - A. Christ OUTLINED the book
    - 1. The things you have SEEN (ch. 1)
    - 2. The things which ARE (chs. 2 and 3)
    - 3. The things which will take place AFTER these things (chs. 4-22)
  - B. Christ EXPLAINED the symbols
    - 1. Seven stars are the ANGELS of the seven churches
      - a. ANGELIC GUARDIANS of individual churches?
      - b. HUMAN MESSENGERS to individual churches?
    - 2. Seven golden lampstands are the seven CHURCHES
      - a. INDEPENDENT of centralized ORGANIZATION
      - b. Answering to CHRIST DIRECTLY
      - c. Acting as LIGHT-BEARERS in the WORLD
